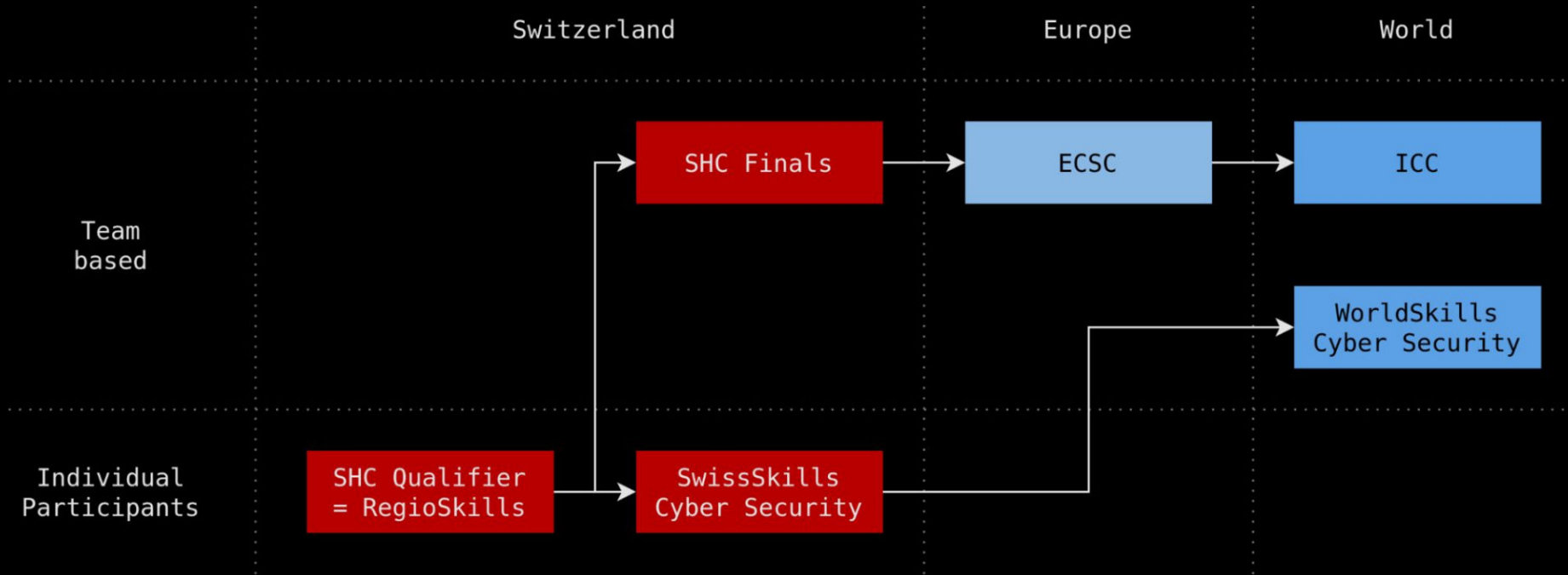

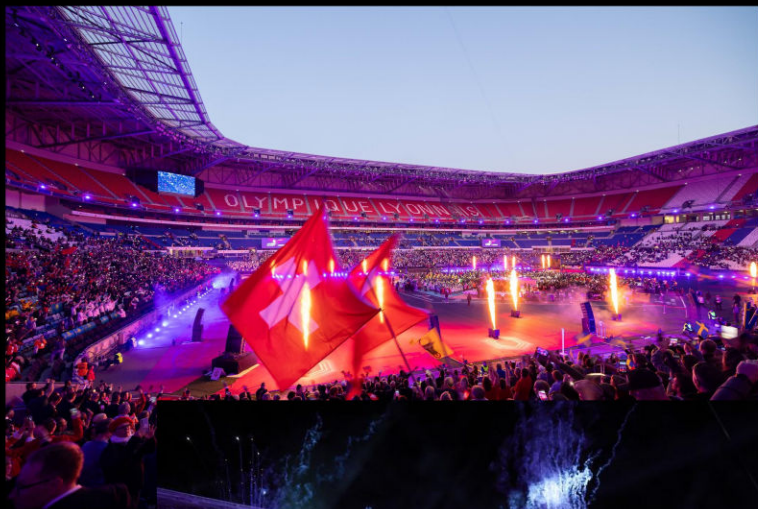

Switzerland:	 7	 7	 1	 21 *	 5

* Medal of excellence (given above a certain grade)

- With 36 medals, Switzerland is the **3rd** best nation in the world
- No medal for **China** in cybersecurity
